#### FROM THE DESK OF BISHOP ESTERKA

#### Dear Friends of our Czech Mission in California



First of all I would like to wish you a blessed and joyous Christmas season and the best of everything for the New Year 2012. Also I would like to invite

for the New Year 2012. Also I would like to invite you to come and join us at our Christmas Masses and programs that follow in all three Missions. We experienced some

difficulties this year with finding an acceptable time for our Christmas Mass in San Francisco. The first idea was to have it on New Year's Day, but it did not suit those who would celebrate St Sylvester and be too sleepy next day. Then I thought we could have the Mass early, on Dec 18. But after considering all the pros and cons, we decided to have the Mass on January 8, the feast of Three Kings.

The end of a year invites reflection on the state of our Missions. In California we have not changed too much during the last few years. It is true that some of the older members have died and, because they are incapacitated because of age, others do not come to join us for our monthly gathering. But on the other hand, we do have individuals and sometimes whole families who have become actively involved in the life of our Missions and, thus, have rejuvenated and enlivened our ranks.

Much more difficult is the situation of those in Canada and Australia. In Canada today we have just one very active and successful Mission/Parish in Toronto where Fr. Libor Svorcik has been pastor for more than ten years. He took upon himself a situation of raging conflict and failing community and because of his patience, perseverance, and willingness to serve people he has turned it around. Now to go there is to feel like a family, with cooperation among people. The parish has become a true center for Czech people. During the year Fr. Libor visits our people in Montreal and Ottowa and even flies to West Canada to three centers there. It goes without saying that it is too much for one person; still he is making it work.

An even worse situation is in Australia where we have large communities of our country-people, especially in Sydney, Melbourne, Perth, and Adalaide. The only Czech priest, Fr. Hrdina, who lives in his religious community in Melbourne, is more than 90 years old. He occasionally celebrates Mass at Sumava. This is clearly not the solution. Without everyday activity and ministry this community will not remain alive and will not be able to flourish. For all of us this is a warning, and an opportunity for us to value what we have and try to improve it.

# In case you are wondering . . .
